Facts found:	_ 1) The boats were on opposite tacks approaching the windward mark to be left to port.
	2) Both boats were more than 3 boat lengths away from the mark
	3) 3790 on port and 3837 on starboard, on the layline and fetching the mark.
	4) As 3790 approached the layline on Port, 3837 hailed 3790 to tack 3 times in the belief there would be a collision if she took no action.
	5) 3790 luffed and passed head to wind. Before getting to close hauled, 3837 on starboard, in anticipation of an imminent collision, luffed and then bore away.
	6) Boats became within 18" of each other and there was no contact.
	7) At this time 3837 was to windward of 3790 and overlapped to the mast.
	8) Wind 8/12 knots
Conclusion:	_ 3790 did not keep clear of 3837 while subject to r13.
