When less than a boat length from 3022 1033 dumped her mainsheet and bore away, passing less than 3 metres astern of 3022. 1033 had a genuine and reasonable apprehension of a collision and bore away to Conclusion: avoid contact. 3022 on port did not keep clear of 1033 on starboard as required by rule10.
