Validity:	Protest valid, hearing continued
Facts found:	Seabiscuit and Defiant were sailing downwind towards the leeward gate. Seabiscuit on starboard and Defiant on port. Seabiscuit gybed onto port 10 boat lengths from the mark. The boats reached the zone with Seabiscuit overlapped inside of Defiant, who was fetching the mark. Defiant held her course, Seabiscuit gybed and came between Defiant and the mark making contact with both. There was no damage.
Conclusion:	Defiant did not give Seabiscuit mark-room as required by rule 18.2(b).
	By touching the mark Seabiscuit broke rule 31 but is exonerated under rule 21 as she sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled. Seabiscuit also broke rule 14 but she is exonerated as the contact did not cause damage or injury.
