Validity:	Protest valid, hearing continued
Facts found:	_3323 and 3279 were sailing upwind towards mark 1. 3323 was on the layline, close-hauled on starboard. 3279 was approaching closehauled on port, on a collision course with 3323. As the boats reached the mark, 3279 began to tack and before reaching closehauled, made contact with 3323. Shortly after, 3279 made contact with the mark There was no damage. 3323 attempted to avoid contact by luffing.
Conclusion:	_3279 did not keep clear of 3323 while tacking. 3279 broke rule 13 and 14.
	By touching the mark, 3279 also broke rule 31.
	It was not reasonably possible for 3323 to avoid contact, 3323 did not break rule 14.
