Facts found:	_Approaching the leeward mark 14134 was in 2 nd position, sailing downwind on starboard. 14138 was ahead in 1 st place.
	The race committee shortened the course for a different class at the leeward mark, by displaying flag S from a race committee boat. The finish mark was in position to the starboard side of the RC boat.
	As 14138 approached the race committee boat, the race officer gestured towards the finish line to indicate the position of the leeward rounding mark.
	14138 changed course, and headed towards the mark. 14138 rounded the leeward mark in first place, and 14134 rounded in second place.
	Both boats finished, 14138 in 1st place and 14134 finished several places later.
Conclusion:	1. 14138 from the RC, received unsolicited outside help.
	2. RC is not an interested source.
	3. The loss of finishing places of 14134 was not as a direct result of the incident.
	4. There was no improper action of the race committee.
